Licence to perform Rigging Basic Level

CPCCLRG3001



Public Cost: \$1,650pp

Course Duration: 5 day on site

Pre-requisites: Dogging ticket, 100 points of identification, adequate literacy & numeracy, USI Number, minimum age 18.

Course Description

This course specifies the skills and knowledge required to safely perform basic rigging work. Riggers use mechanical load shifting equipment and associated gear to move, place or secure loads, including plant, equipment or members of a structure. Riggers ensure the stability of those members and set up and dismantle hoists. This course applies to rigging work involving structural steel erection, hoists, pre-cast concrete members of a structure, safety nets and static lines, mast climbing work platforms, perimeter safety screens and shutters, cantilevered crane platforms.

Course Content:

The course outlines the following:

- Plan task
- Select and inspect equipment
- Set up task
- Undertake basic rigging activities
- Complete task

Course Requirements: Dogging ticket, 100 points of identification, adequate literacy & numeracy, USI Number, minimum age 18, appropriate clothing hi-vis shirt and covered shoes or boots, food and drinks.

Mode of delivery: Face to face training

Location: 26 Piper Drive Ballina or at your worksite (for groups)

Course Fees: A deposit of \$1,000 is required within 7 days of enrolment, with the balance to be paid upon commencement.

Course Outcome: Upon successful completion participants will receive a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment in Licence to perform rigging basic level CPCCLRG3001 from North Coast Training Company and an application for a SafeWork NSW High Risk Work Licence.

Important: Within 60 days of successfully completing the above course, the applicant MUST take their application form, certificate of competency, evidence of identity, passport photo and \$90 for the SafeWork fee to a main Australia Post Office for processing.

Anyone assessed as 'not yet competent' can be reassessed on the relevant section after 48 hours from the original assessment date, and before 90 days have elapsed. (After 90 days a full reassessment will be needed)

Note: Licence to perform rigging basic level is valid for 5 years.
