Licence to operate a materials hoist

CPCCLHS3002A



Public Cost: POA

Course Duration: 3 days on site

Pre-requisites: 100 points of identification, adequate literacy & numeracy, USI Number, minimum age 18.

Course Description

This course specifies the outcomes required to operate a materials hoist being a builder's hoist by which only goods or materials and not personnel may be hoisted and where the car, bucket or platform is cantilevered from, and travels up and down externally to, a face of the support structure.

Course Content:

The course outlines the following:

- Plan work
- Conduct routine checks
- Conduct hoist operations
- Shut down and secure hoist

Course Requirements: 100 points of identification, adequate literacy & numeracy, USI Number, minimum age 18, appropriate clothing hi-vis shirt and covered shoes or boots, food and drinks.

Mode of delivery: Face to face training

Location: 26 Piper Drive Ballina or at your worksite (for groups)

Course Fees: A deposit of \$1,000 is required within 7 days of enrolment, with the balance to be paid upon commencement.

Course Outcome: Upon successful completion participants will receive a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment in Licence to operate a materials hoist CPCCLHS3002A from North Coast Training Company and an application for a SafeWork NSW High Risk Work Licence.

Important: Within 60 days of successfully completing the above course, the applicant MUST take their application form, certificate of competency, evidence of identity, passport photo and \$77 for the SafeWork fee to a main Australia Post Office for processing.

Anyone assessed as 'not yet competent' can be reassessed on the relevant section after 48 hours from the original assessment date, and before 90 days have elapsed. (After 90 days a full reassessment will be needed)

Note: Licence to operate a materials hoist is valid for 5 years.
